From the CMD's Desk

Dear colleagues,

This being the first issue of AAINA for the year 2014, I take this opportunity to share with you the progress made by the company.

The global macro economic conditions have impacted the Indian business scenario as well. However, by planning ahead, remaining sharply focused, building specialization thereby creating differentiation to compete effectively, we have been able to respond proactively to market dynamics. In fact, it will be key to how we innovate and expand our business, retaining our competitive edge.

You have my assurance that the organization, on its part, will fulfill its responsibility of providing everyone an opportunity to grow, it expects you to be in the continuous learning mode so as to be able to discharge your obligations towards the company by delivering high quality outputs conforming to the rapidly changing market needs.

I have always maintained that the client-focus is our priority and all the initiatives undertaken by us are directed at client satisfaction. It is the trust and confidence reposed by them in HSCC that has allowed us to move forward with an excellent perspective.

Let us move forward with self-belief our ambitions higher, our commitments deeper and our efforts greater towards sustained value creation, taking company to the next level.


Financial Highlights














2nd Induction Training Programme - 2013




