This being the first issue of AAINA for the year 2014, I take this opportunity to share with you the progress made by the company.

The global macro economic conditions have impacted the Indian business scenario as well. 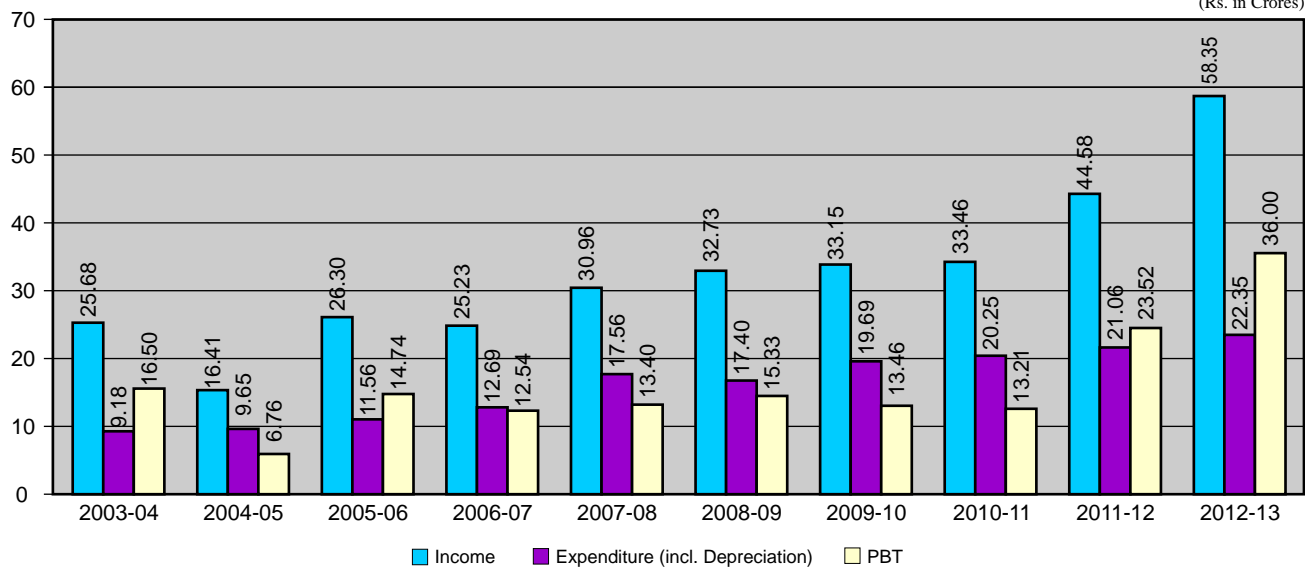
