1. <u>Amendment to The Document</u>

- i. At any time prior to the deadline for the submission of Applications, HSCC, may, for any reason modify the document by an amendment.
- ii. The amendments would also be available on the website on HSCC. The Applicants are strongly advised to regularly visit this website to ensure that they are aware of the amendments. The addendum (s) issued will form part of the documents.

- 2. <u>Preparation of Application:</u>
 - a) Responsibility:
 - i. The Applicant shall be deemed to have inspected the Site and its surroundings and taken into account all relevant factors pertaining to the Site, while preparing and submitting the Application.
 - b) Project Inspection and Site Visit:

Any Site information given in this Application Document is for guidance only. 3. <u>Contents of Financial Package</u>

The financial package (Price Schedule) should be submitted in hard copy only. These prices should include all costs associated with the Project including any out of pocket / mobilization expenses, taxes, charges, levies, cess, VAT, including Service tax etc. as applicable till the date of document publication. In case Government levies/modifies any tax subsequently the same will be adjusted plus/minus as the case may be. The Applicant must ensure to fill up price against each item of Price application. If any cell is left blank then value of that cell shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).

4. <u>Currency of Application</u>

Application prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only. The amount mentioned elsewhere in the application document will also deemed to be in Indian Rupees unless otherwise mentioned.

5. HSCC may, at their discretion, extend date for last date of submission, in which case all rights and obligations of HSCC and the Applicant shall thereafter be subjected to the new deadline as extended. i. Late Applications

Any Application received at the address mentioned above after the deadline prescribed for submission of Applications in Notice Inviting Applications/extended date as the case may be, herein will not be considered and will be returned unopened to the Applicant.

6. <u>Application Opening</u>

Applications shall then be opened in the office of HSCC (I) Ltd., at Plot – 6 (A), Block – E, Sector – 1, Noida, Uttar Pradesh – 201 301, an hour after the prescribed time for Application submission in presence of the Applicants' representatives who may wish to be present.

<u>Financial Bid</u> for all applicant whose application is found to be generally in order and substantially responsive shall be opened at the Bid opening or at a subsequent date to be intimated in advance to such eligible Applicants.

Only summary of prices quoted by the Applicants will be read out.

Price evaluation shall be made on total mention in price schedule.

The Application of any Applicant who has not complied with any of the instructions contained herein may not be considered.

Process to be Confidential

After the public opening of Applications/bids, information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparisons of Applications and recommendations concerning the Award of Contract shall not be disclosed to Applicants or other persons not officially concerned with such process.

Any effort by the Applicant to influence the Employer/ Engineer in the process of examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of Applications and decision concerning Award of Contract may result in the rejection of the bidder's bid.

Determination of Responsiveness

- i. Prior to the detailed evaluation of Applications, HSCC will determine whether each Application is responsive to the requirements of the tender.
- ii. For the purpose of this clause, a responsive Application is one which:
 - a. contains all the information as requested in the Application Document
 - b. contains information in formats same/similar as those specified in this Application Document
 - c. Conforms to all the terms, conditions and specifications of Tender without material deviation or reservation. "Deviation" may include exceptions and exclusions. A material deviation or reservation is one which affects, in any substantial way, the scope, quality, performance or administration of the works to be undertaken by the Applicant under the Contract, or which limits in any substantial way, HSCC 's rights or the Applicant's obligations under the Contract as provided in Application and/or is of an essential condition, the rectification of which would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids at reasonable price.
- iii. If a bid is not substantially responsive to the requirements of Application, it will be rejected by HSCC. The decision of the HSCC in this regard shall be final and binding.

7. Evaluation of Applications

Annexure-I TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

INTRODUCTION

50 Mbps Internet connectivity on FOC Leased Line (1:1 uncompressed and unshared) for HSCC India Limited, Noida.

SCOPE OF WORK

To cater the Internet bandwidth and connectivity requirement, HSCC intends to hire 50 Mbps dedicated uncompressed symmetric FOC Internet Leased Line (1:1 uncompressed and unshared) Connectivity through Leased Line with assured bandwidth of 50 Mbps at HSCC, Noida, on end-to-end basis per annum. HSCC is indenting to utilize the required bandwidth to be made available uninterrupted for 24 X 7 X 365 basis on reliable media i.e. fiber optic for running various common network services such as Internet access, web mail etc. If any earthwork/minor civil work is involved inside the premises it should be done by the applicant without any extra cost in intimation to the HSCC.

The applicant shall provide all the equipment such as mux, modems, converters, routers, UPS and any other hardware required to terminate the internet leased line at HSCC, Noida without any additional charges. Maintenance of the same during the contract period is the responsibility of the agency/service provider. HSCC, Noida shall provide power and space for co-locating the termination equipment without any charges. The applicant must specify in the application the space and power requirements for their equipment.

PERIOD OF SERVICE:

- 1. Set-up of 50 Mbps Internet Leased Line on FOC at HSCC, Noida completion within 4 weeks from date of placement of order.
- 2. Providing services of 50 Mbps Internet Leased Line for the period of 5 year. The applicant shall provide the services under the contract valid for a period of 01 year starting from the date of Commissioning & Acceptance of the HSCC. However, the services will be reviewed and renewed on yearly basis based on the performance of the agency/service provider so that it can be renewed as per the requirement of the HSCC.

The service provider shall be responsible for Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning & Maintenance of the Internet connectivity & to ensure 99.5% uptime of the Internet Leased Line provided, on monthly basis.

The technical requirements with terms and conditions are given below:

1. I P Addresses

The ISP shall provide 50 Mbps Internet connectivity (Leased Line) at HSCC. Internet Router Port at ISP Gateway for required Bandwidth and minimum 5 Public IP addresses including Reverse Lookups configured at these IP's.

- 2. The applicant shall do installation & configuration of modems, routers or any such associated Fiber-optic equipment to make the entire system working to provide sustained Internet Leased Line of not less than 50 Mbps.
- 3. Local Loop has to be through Fiber Cable, wherein optical fiber is extended right up to the customer premises.
- 4. Complete detail of service provisioning including offered bandwidth, compression type,

termination details etc. are to be clearly stated.

- 5. Service Provider should provide details of the proposed connectivity, viz., the name of the cable and landing points of the involved cable.
- 6. The ISP's network shall support IPv6 and all necessary technical support for implementation shall be provided to HSCC as and when required.
- 7. The service provider shall carry out proactive maintenance, management and monitoring of the Internet Leased Line links to meet the desired SLA. The applicant must also provide methodology for problem management, resolution and escalation.
- 8. The applicants Network Operation Centre must respond to the complaints from HSCC on in the event of any failure or any attacks from internet on 24X7X365 basis.

Service Performance Deliverables

- 1) The applicant must have a state of the art Network Management Centre or Network Operation Centre to ensure complete monitoring and process driven support to enable trouble shooting of all types of problems.
- 2) The applicant should be capable of providing Bandwidth usage reports, Performance reports on Real time /Hourly /Daily/ Weekly /Monthly basis & Network latency reports. Latency should be less than 150 ms from HSCC to ISP's tier 1 peering point.
- 3) Planned Downtime:-

There shall however, be a provision for planned maintenance activity in the service providers' network for which the service provider shall inform HSCC at least 10 working days in advance. The maximum window for such maintenance shall not exceed 8 hours in six months with a single block not exceeding 4 hours at a stretch. The downtime period taken for the planned maintenance activity shall be made available only during off-peak hours and as advised by HSCC.

5) Damages for Service Failure:

If the Uptime of 99.5% is not met for any duration of time, the link shall be deemed to be down for such duration and penalty shall be imposed.

Damages for failing to maintain the stipulated internet port/link uptime of 99.5 % on monthly basis shall be calculated as under.

If the uptime (%) per month is less than 97% for 2 consecutive months, HSCC reserves the right

to review and terminate the contract.

Other terms & conditions are mentioned below:

- 1.0 The bidder should have fully resilient and self-healing network architecture, on fiber medium.
- 1.1 Packet Losses: Less than 2 % (Average over 1000 ping) at any given point of time to any part of globe.
- 1.2 The Vendor will be responsible for the comprehensive maintenance during the service period after the acceptance of installation & testing of hardware for which HSCC will not make any extra payment.
- 1.3 The HSCC reserves the right to carry out the capability assessment of the applicant and the HSCCC decision shall be final in this regard.
- 1.4 Compliance of terms with any deviation should be clearly indicated in remarks in separate deviation sheet.
- 1.5 The applicant would insure that the local loop provisioning does not violate regulations as laid by Government of India/TRAI in respect of such links/networks. Applicant will be responsible for making all the payments towards the local loop charges/rentals charges etc.
- 1.6 The bidder must submit, the detailed schematics/network diagrams explaining the implementation scheme, route map of the proposed connectivity along with their proposal. The proposal should clearly bring out the Bill of Material (BOM), the space and power required in HSCC's Internet data center required to commission and provision the Internet connectivity.
- 1.7 The applicant must have adequate support facility in NCR/Delhi to provide proper customer support 24X7X365.

The applicant should have well defined capabilities and procedures to track call resolution progress status and provide the updates to the customer. In addition, applicant should have well defined management and technical escalation procedures.

- 1.8 The bidder has to provide monthly Multi Router Traffic Grapher (MRTG) Report of usage of Bandwidth and will ensure that HSCC is getting 50 Mbps (1:1 uncompressed and unshared) Bandwidth.
- 1.9 During the contract period if there is any reduction in the tariffs for Internet Lease Line in the market due to changes in Government policy etc., the benefit of subsequent price reduction shall be immediately passed on to HSCC.
- 1.10 During currency of the contract, HSCC reserves the right to re-negotiate on the tariffs being charged, based on market conditions, after one year apart from any other reductions in tariffs due to Government policies.
- 1.11 HSCC at any time may terminate the Contract by giving written notice of one month in advance to the selected agency/service provider, without any compensation, if the selected agency/service provider becomes bankrupt of otherwise insolvent, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy which has accrued or will accrue thereafter to HSCC.

Payment Terms

The standard payment terms shall be as below:

- I. The 100% payment for One Time Charges, if any of the contract value will be made by HSCC after successful commissioning of Internet lease line and acceptance test at the HSCC' office in terms of agreement.
- II. The payment of recurring charges will be made on quarterly basis subject to the performance of the satisfactory services and against the submission of the invoice on the completion of each quarter.

Deduction of Taxes as applicable shall be made from each bill.

User Acceptance Tests (UAT)

User Acceptance Testing (UAT) consists of a process of test by the user that the application developed according the specifications mentioned in tender document and accepted by the users. The handing over to HSCC shall be effective only after compliance of the following:

- a) Rectification of all defects shall be carried out by the agency before Handing over/Taking over process.
- b) All services/equipments/Hardware/Software/Application Software/Network to be run and check as per requirements and satisfaction of HSCC.
- c) Agency shall submit catalogues, brochures, operation manual, manufacturer test certificate, Guaranty/Warranty papers, licence etc for all equipments/Hardware/Software before handing over & taking over process.

Handing over & Taking over process

For handing over & taking over process in addition to clauses specified the following services/works to be complied by the agency/service provider:-

- c) Rectification of all defects shall be carried out by the agency before Handing over/Taking over process.
- d) All services/equipments/Hardware/Software/Application Software/Network to be run and check as per requirements and satisfaction of HSCC.
- c) Agency shall submit catalogues, brochures, operation manual, manufacturer test certificate, Guaranty/Warranty papers, licence etc for all equipments/Hardware/Software before handing over & taking over process.

Arbitration

The venue/ seat of Arbitration shall be at Delhi. During the arbitration the agency/service provider shall not stop the work & shall continue to work in terms of the contact.
